Unit 2 includes the Agency for Economic and Forecasting, Agency Analyses for Privatization of Government and Municipal Property, Commission for Protection of Competition, High Certifying Commission, Main Administration-Archives, Main Administration-Economics of Defense and National Reserves, National Intelligence Service, National Statistical Institute, Agency for Foreign Investments, Main Administration-Road Construction, Patent Agency, Main Administration-Social Security, and Council for Mutual Insurance of Members of Producer Cooperatives.

Unit 4 comprises mainly the following extrabudgetary accounts of the Fiscal Reserve: Professional Qualification and Unemployment Fund, Social Assistance Fund, Labor Conditions for Fund. National Fund Environmental Protection, National Fund for Republican Road Forestry Fund. Network. National Communication System Fund, Tobacco Fund, Agricultural Fund. Air Traffic Control Administration, Rehabilitation and Social Integration Fund, Penal Institutions Premises Fund, Court Premises Fund, Imprisonment Procedures Fund, Fund for Financing the Concessions Expenditures, Fund for Safety and Storage of Radioactive Waste Products, Nuclear Equipment Prevention, National Donation Fund Thirteen Centuries Bulgaria, Housing Construction Fund, National Palace of Culture Fund, Government Dividend Fund, National Compensation Housing Fund, Radio and Television Fund, Privatization Expenditures Fund, Extra-budgetary Account for Receipts under Memorandum etc., Extra-budgetary Account for the National Assembly State Gazette.

### **Data Coverage**

Data in central government tables cover operations of units 1-4. Unit 2 includes social security operations, and units 3 and 4 are extrabudgetary.

Data in local government tables cover operations of unit 5. This institutional table is based on information reported in 1999.
