Unit 4 comprises Health and Social Security Funds and extra-budgetary accounts of the ministries and state agencies: (Professional

Qualification and Unemployment Fund, National Environment Fund, Rehabilitation and Social Protection Fund, National Donation Fund, National Compensation Housing Fund, Radio and Television Fund, State Gazette Account, Safety and Storage of Nuclear Waste Fund, Nuclear Equipment Prevention Fund, National Fund at Ministry of Finance; Privatization Fund; State Fund for Agriculture, Account for Compensation of Former Owners and Users of Farm Land, Concession Expenditures Fund, Bulgarian Forestry Fund)

Data for Local Government cover operations of unit 5-6

Unit 6 comprises the following extra-budgetary accounts: Special Account for Revenues from Privatization; Privatization Expenditures Fund; Special Fund for Investments and Fixed Assets; Housing Building Fund; Account with the Municipal Service for Social Assistance, Environment Fund.
